New Clause

After clause 14 insert -

'Offence of coercive abortion

14A. After Regulation 11 of the Abortion (Northern Ireland) (No. 2) Regulations 2020 (Offence to terminate a pregnancy otherwise than in accordance with these Regulations), insert—

"Offence of coercive abortion

- 11A.—(1) A person commits an offence if they take the following actions towards a pregnant woman which leads to a termination of pregnancy—
 - (a) using force or the threat of force;
 - (b) psychological or emotional abuse;
 - (c) controlling or coercive behaviour; or
 - (d) administering any substance capable of causing a termination without the informed consent of that pregnant woman.
 - (2) Paragraph (1) applies regardless of whether the person—
 - (a) knew the woman was pregnant;
 - (b) intended to cause a termination of pregnancy.
- (3) A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable on conviction on indictment to imprisonment for life."
